

Families are encouraged to attend! A scavenger hunt game is provided to help kids engage with the art



### OMAHA NEBRASKA STAKE MISSIONARY WORK





### TEMPLE & FAMILY HISTORY INVITATION

After announcing plans to construct 17 more temples in the October 2024 General Conference, President Russell M. Nelson stated: "My dear brothers and sisters, do you see what is happening right before our eyes? I pray that we will not miss the majesty of this moment! The Lord is indeed hastening His work." (Reference 1) While all are invited to participate in this work, the prophets and apostles have extended special invitations to the youth. Elder David A. Bednar of the Quorum of the Twelve Apostles shared:

"The Lord has made available in our day remarkable resources that enable you to learn about and love this work that is sparked by the Spirit of Elijah. For example, FamilySearch is a collection of records, resources, and services easily accessible with personal computers and a variety of handheld devices, designed to help people discover and document their family history. These resources also are available in the family history centers located in many of our Church buildings throughout the world."

"...I invite the young people of the Church to learn about and experience the Spirit of Elijah. I encourage you to study, to search out your ancestors, and to prepare yourselves to perform proxy baptisms in the house of the Lord for your kindred dead (see D&C 124:28–36). And I urge you to help other people identify their family histories." (Reference 2)

Since January 2018, President Russell M. Nelson has announced plans to construct 185 temples (Reference 3). This is truly remarkable and makes his following statement highly impactful:

"My dear brothers and sisters. construction of these temples may not change your life, but your time in the temple surely will. In that spirit, I bless you to identify those things you can set aside so you can spend more time in the temple. I bless you with greater harmony and love in your homes and a deeper desire to care for your eternal family relationships. I bless you with increased faith in the Lord Jesus Christ and a greater ability to follow Him as His true disciples." (Reference 4, emphasis added)

I invite us all to act on the prophetic invitations we have received. For any seeking family history assistance, please speak with one of your Ward Temple and Family History Consultants or come visit the FamilySearch Center! For younger youth, we are excited to offer a Summer Temple and Family History Class at the FamilySearch Center – please see the announcement on the next page.

### YOUTH SUMMER TEMPLE & FAMILY HISTORY CLASS

A Temple and Family History Class for younger youth (turning 12 or 13 in 2025) will be held at the Omaha FamilySearch Center on June 24-27! Please see the details below:

- When is the class? Classes will be held Tuesday through Friday, June 24-27. The classes will be held each day in the morning and will be 1 hour in length. Exact times will be determined based on the number of registrants and classes needed; up to three class times will be held each day.
- Who is invited to attend? Young men and young women turning 12 or 13 in 2025 (birth years 2013 and 2012) are invited to attend the class. See Learn More.
- What will be covered? This is a class for beginners and will include instruction and activities in the areas of FamilySearch navigation and use, writing journals and personal histories, research basics, preparing for temple work, and ways to be involved in family history this summer and beyond!
- Where will class be held? The class will be held at the Omaha FamilySearch Center which is located on the north side of the Stake Center.
- How can I register? Click <u>REGISTRATION</u>. Parents are encouraged to help their youth through the registration form. Registration will close May 25 (or when classes are full).
- Prerequisites: Participants need a FamilySearch account and need to know or bring their login and password! Youth are able to create accounts with parental permission. Parents, please assist your youth with account setup. See Learn More.

### Sojourn in the Wilderness:

Pioneers' stories of faith, and sacrifice are brought to life, offering a glimpse into the rich tapestry of their lives..

Sojourn in the Wilderness is an exciting project aimed at bringing to life the inspiring stories of the early pioneer members of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints through captivating animations. This project is designed to create an engaging platform that showcases the determination and resilience of these pioneers but also serves as a valuable resource for their descendants and others who share in the pioneer heritage...

Early members of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints faced numerous challenges while fleeing mobs in Nauvoo, Illinois. They sought peace and a place to practice their faith while navigating difficult terrains and harsh weather.

Upon reaching the Missouri River, the pioneers established Winter Quarters and at least 90 settlements in the Middle Missouri Valley, providing refuge for these brave pioneers. These settlements fostered community support and resource sharing.

After two years, as groups moved west, many pioneers returned to Iowa, establishing settlements that contributed to regional growth.

Today, technology and research illuminate the lives of these pioneers. Platforms like MyHeritage and the scholarly research of Dr. Shauna C. Anderson Young help preserve their stories and celebrate their experiences.
